From The Pastor's Desk

The 10 Rules for Respect

As Sally & I begin our new ministry with and among you, one of the things we're looking forward to is getting to know people and building relationships. That will actually be our top priority over the course of the summer. Considering that Sally grew up in the area, she has a significant head start, so I have my work cut out for me.

Of course, one of the foundations for good, lasting relationships is respect. To respect means to show esteem for; to honor. I Peter 2:17 says *"Show proper respect for everyone: Love the brotherhood of believers, fear God, honor the king."*

Recently, I came across the "10 rules for respect." The church that developed them agreed with one another to follow these "rules" in the course of their everyday interactions. While I'm not sure I like the term "rules," they are definitely worth thinking about and applying throughout the day.

1. If I have a problem with another person, I will go to that person privately.
2. If someone has a problem with me, I want him to come to me privately and will try to be open to whatever the concern or issue.
3. If someone has a problem with me, and comes to you, send the person to me. (I'll do the same for you.)
4. I will be careful about "spiritualizing" my position on an issue. That I prayed about the matter is usually not an argument for or against anything.
5. Be careful how you interpret me – I'd rather do that. (Again, I will do the same for you.)
6. I will speak well of you and assume good intentions.
7. If it's confidential, I won't tell (unless someone is harming himself or someone else).
8. I won't send or pay attention to unsigned letters or notes.
9. I will not manipulate; I will not be manipulated.
10. When in doubt, I will bring up my concern or question.

These are some difficult rules to keep, but would no doubt be helpful in fostering good relationships throughout the church body. As your pastor, I will try to set a good example.
